

Scope: ERA-NET Cofund 2018 Joint Call

The Water JPI 2018 Joint Call will pool R&I efforts from countries participating in the Water JPI. The scope of the Call was defined in accordance with the principles of the Water JPI SRIA, as follows:

- All societal forms of water use are within the scope of the Call;
- All aquatic ecosystems subject to impacts as described in the <u>Water JPI SRIA</u> are within the scope of the Call.

IMPORTANT

Proposals should focus on fresh waters and may consider transitional waters; those on marine system will not be eligible.



Call description: ERA-NET Cofund 2018 Joint Call

The FPOs particularly wish to:

- i) Promote transdisciplinary research;
- ii) Encourage proposals combining basic and applied approaches;
- iii) Stimulate mobility of researchers within the consortia;
- iv) Enhance collaborative R&I during the project's lifespan and beyond; and
- v) Promote international cooperation in the water area.



Call description: ERA-NET Cofund 2018 Joint Call

Proposals are expected to:

- Address one or up to three themes;
- Address <u>at least one of the entire sub-topics</u> listed in the call announcement – Applicants are encouraged to integrate more than one sub-theme in their proposals;
- Address at least one of the UN SDG targets 6 and 13
- Go beyond the State of the Art
- Propose case studies at local or regional level in Europe and beyond
- Consider Gender dimension
- And Encourage International participation in Water R&I in different environments

Open access and open data

The optimization of the impact of publicly-funded scientific research is of fundamental importance to improve conditions to

- minimise the time spent searching for and accessing information,
- speed up scientific progress and
- make it easier to cooperate across and beyond the EU.



Eligibility: ERA-NET Cofund 2018 Joint Call

Main Rules (I)

Each consortium must be composed of at least a minimum of <u>three eligible partners</u> that <u>request funding from participating Funding Partner Organisations</u> from <u>three</u> <u>different countries</u>;

Proposals should be submitted by Universities and other higher education institutions, public research institutions, private non-profit organisations, and private companies, according to National/Regional Regulations;

A partner in a proposal is defined as i) a principal investigator that requests funds or ii) a principal investigator that contributes with own funds to the proposal;

all proposals should emphasise participation of stakeholders, and dissemination and exploitation of results.



Eligibility: ERA-NET Cofund 2018 Joint Call

Main Rules (II)

- Proposals MUST be received before the deadlines;
- Proposals MUST meet all the formal criteria (submitted electronically, respect page limits and number/type of attachments allowed, written in English language);
- Topics of proposals MUST be fully relevant to the scope of the call;
- Maximum <u>requested</u> global budget per proposal: I.5 M€;
- Duration of projects: MUST be between 24 to 36 months;
- Open Access requirements for all scientific publications produced by the projects funded by the Joint Call.



National/Regional Regulations: ERA-NET Cofund 2018 Joint Call

In addition to the General Eligibility Criteria...

• Each partner should contact their National Contact Point (see Call Announcement, chapter X) to assure the full compliance with the National/Regional Eligibility Criteria, as described in the National/Regional Regulations.

Each partner must ensure that his/her contribution to the overall project conforms to:

- Where applicable, relevance of the topic(s)/subtopic(s) of the proposals to national/regional programmes and strategies;
- Compliance with national funding criteria and regulations;
- Compliance with limits to budget requests, or any other aspects detailed in the documentation available.



How to complete Part B

Part B of the proposal contains the details of the proposed research and collaborative efforts. At the preproposal stage, the practical arrangements planned to implement the proposal (this will relate to the Quality and Efficiency of the Implementation Section of the Full Proposal at second stage) will not be evaluated by the independent experts. We would advise you to address each of the award criteria as outlined in the following sections. Please note that the explanatory notes below serve to explain the evaluation criteria without being exhaustive.



Applicants must structure their proposal according to the headings indicated in the Part B preproposal template below.

Applicants must ensure that their pre-proposals conform to the layout and to the instructions given on this page. The maximum total length of sections 1 to 3 of Part B of the proposal is 5 pages. Taken into consideration that the overall document will have one page for the cover and one page for the table of contents, the overall page count must be 7 at maximum.

There is no specific page limit per each individual section of Part B. Within the overall five-page limit, applicants are therefore free to decide on the length dedicated to each section.

Please remember that it is your responsibility to comply with the page limit and all other formal eligibility criteria. Proposals not meeting all these criteria will be declined without further review.



The page size is A4, and all margins (top, bottom, left, right) should be at least 15 mm (not including any footers or headers). This document has the correct format and font. Use this as your starting document and delete where appropriate. Use the same font and style for the whole

proposal (Times New Roman, 11 pt, single spacing).

Literature references should be listed in footnotes, font size 9. However, regardless of the format used, all footnotes will count towards the page limit.

Please make sure that the Part B of your proposal carries as a header to each page the proposal acronym. All pages should be numbered in a single series on the footer of the page to prevent errors during handling. The numbering format "Page X of Y" should be used.


