- Review proposed layout of draft Common Strategy Principles based on:
 - Outputs from previous stages
 - Outputs from other related IC4Water tasks
- Other Preparatory Workshops
 - Workshop "Public Private Partnerships Business models » Delayed due to Covid I9 crisis
 - Aims: Establish modalities Action plan for possible Public Private cooperation in RDI programming
 - Workshop with JPI Members (October 2020)
 - Aims: To discuss and progress draft Common Strategy
 - Workshop with Neighbouring countries (November 2020)
 - Aims: identify specific needs for International River Basin conditions (water diplomacy)
- Progressing discussions with BELMONT Forum investigating possible ways / mechanisms for cooperation (on-going)
- Integrating inputs from all actions
- Final Workshop with JPI Governing Board to discuss
 - Aims: assess proposed strategy and decide
 - Schedule: September 2021
