

## JPI Urban Europe – Facts & Figures

**an intergovernmental R&I initiative  
on urban transitions and  
sustainable urban development**

- 20 European countries participating
- ~ 100 million Euro public investment for joint calls
- 9 calls implemented, thereof 4 in cooperation with H2020
- 80+ projects funded
- 25+ European funding agencies cooperating
- Cooperation schemes with Belmont Forum and China established

## Expectations for International Outreach

- Develop common framework conditions for international collaboration anticipating the needs of inter- and transdisciplinary research and innovation

## STRATEGIC POLICY COOPERATION

- Establish strategic relationships with policy makers and networks
- Gain knowledge about urban priorities and strategies


## COMMUNITY BUILDING

- Identify relevant international R&I programmes
- Set up joint calls with international partners considering JPI Urban Europe and partners' portfolios
