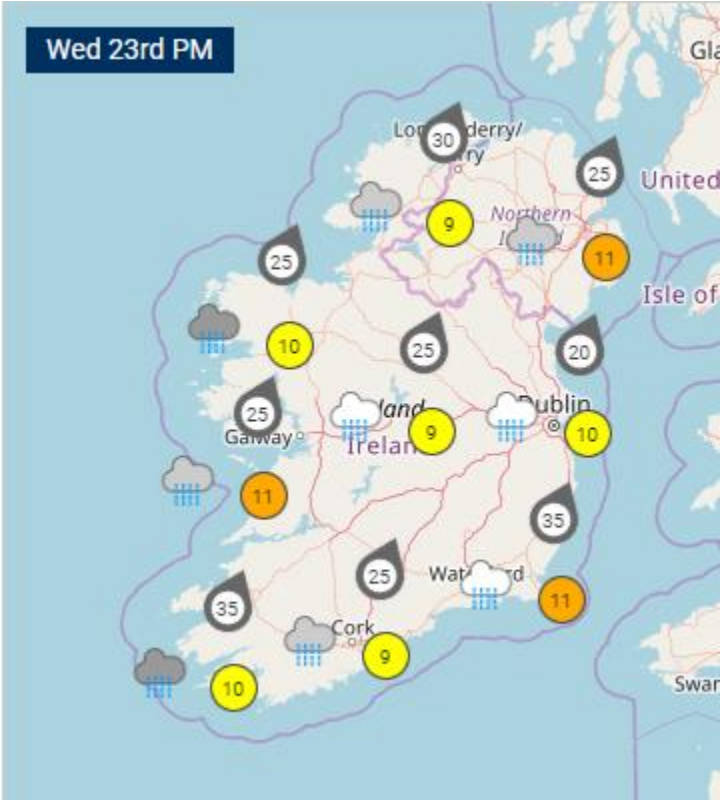
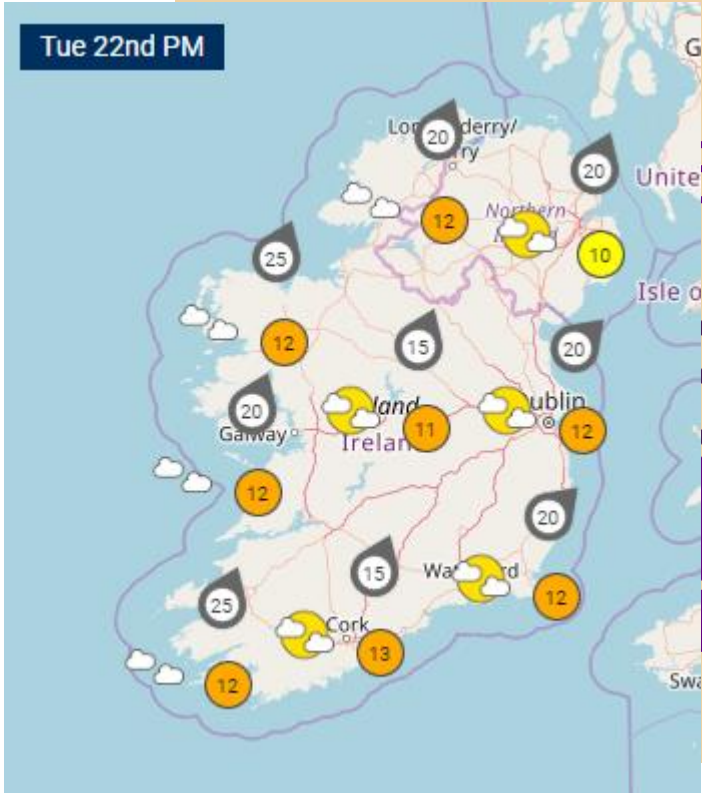

Proposed Research Priorities following Consultation – Nature/Ecosystems

Research Priority Level

Sub-Theme

(SRIA 2.0 Sub- themes in red)

Cross-cutting issues: Big data, SDGs (6, 13 & 15) & climate change

Identified Research Priorities

General comments

- Conservation of biodiversity and ecosystem function is the goal
- Need for assessment of multiple risks missing, and event triggered augmentation (e.g. knock on effects due to extreme events).
- Need to consider water quality, as well as quantity and temperature (climate change as a key driver).

Subtheme 1.1: Developing approaches for assessing and optimising the value of ecosystems

Ecosystem Services

- Recognising the value of ecosystem services in land use decisions and land use options.
- Research and innovation to develop robust indicators to monitor

Artificial aquatic ecosystems

- Understanding/measuring possible role of artificial aquatic ecosystems to compensate overexploitation of the natural ones;
