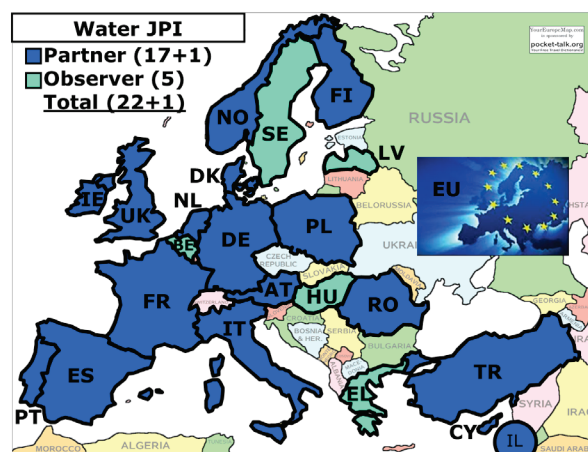

AUSTRIA: NEW WATER JPI PARTNER

Last October 8th, Austria became Partner of the Water JPI. We want to express a warm welcome to our Austrian partners from the Federal Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry, Environment and Water Management.

The Water JPI is currently composed by 18 partners (17 countries plus the European Commission). Five additional countries are observing the process. In February 1st, 2011 (Newsletter #4) the Water JPI was

composed by 14 partners. This increase in critical mass is very important to achieve the goals of the Water JPI.



PROGRESS IN WATEUR

WatEUR is the FP7 Coordination and Support Action (CSA) directly contributing to the development of the Water JPI. The intense administrative process to kick WatEUR off is now in clear progress. The Grant Agreement has been signed by the Coordinator (MINECO) and the European Commission, and accession by Partners is now being completed. WatEUR will develop between January 1st, 2013 and December 31st, 2015.

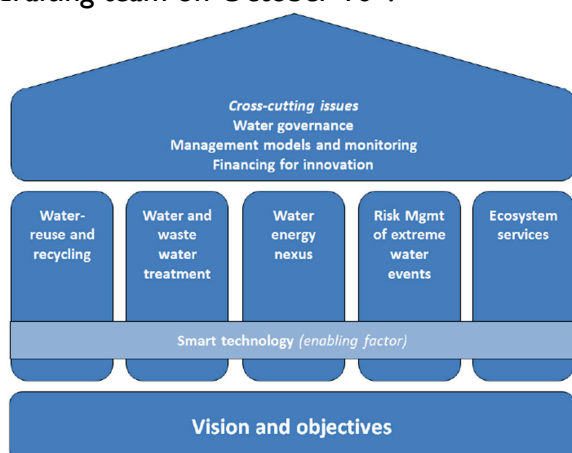


THE EIP ON WATER

This Innovation Partnership has made relevant progress during this month. The Task Force identified priorities in addition to those proposed by the High Level Steering Group. Drafting teams were created at the Task Force meeting (September 25th). The Water JPI asked its Scientific and Technological Board three questions about each EIP priority:

- Is this priority ready for innovation?
- What are the major bottlenecks limiting innovation?
- Which topics are innovation-ready?

A dossier containing summary responses to these questions was sent to each priority drafting team on October 16th.




The first working draft of the Strategic Implementation Plan (SIP) has now been produced by the drafting teams. The Water JPI will continue contributing to the drafting of the SIP through a critical review of the first working draft.

MEETINGS IN OCTOBER 2012

A two-day Water JPI meeting was held on October 16 and 17 in Rome. The first meeting focused on warming-up WatEUr in anticipation of its kick off early in 2013. Work package and Task leaders presented detailed plans. The second meeting gathered the Water JPI Executive Board for the fourth time.

JPIs TO CO-WORK WORKSHOPS

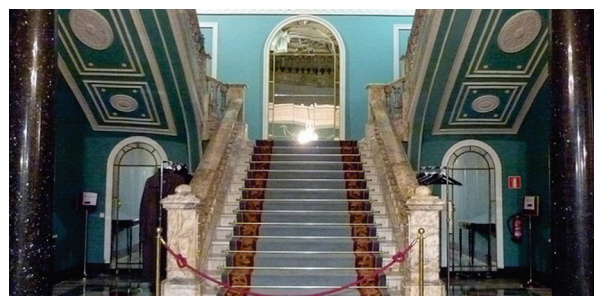
